20 definitions of the true Prophet of God!

Answer:

While almost all Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, and Teachers falsely say that Moses was the First Prophet of God Almighty, the truth is that Abraham was rather the First Prophet of God Almighty long before even Moses was born! Let us consider the following verses to confirm our doctrine:

Genesis 20:1 (KJV) And Abraham journeyed from thence toward the south country, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and sojourned in Gerar.

Genesis 20:2 (**KJV**) And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She *is* my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

Genesis 20:3 (KJV) But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou *art but* a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she *is* a man's wife.

Genesis 20:4 (KJV) But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, Lord, wilt thou slay also a righteous nation?

Genesis 20:5 (KJV) Said he not unto me, She *is* my sister? and she, even she herself said, He *is* my brother: in the integrity of my heart and innocency of my hands have I done this.

Genesis 20:6 (KJV) And God said unto him in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from sinning against me: therefore suffered I thee not to touch her.

Genesis 20:7 (KJV) Now therefore restore the man *his* wife; for

he *is* a prophet, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore *her* not, know thou that thou shalt surely die, thou, and all that *are* thine.

According to the Word of God in **Genesis 20:7** (**KJV**), there is no denying the truth that Abraham was rather the First Prophet of God Almighty long before even Moses was born!

The reason why so-called Men of God are quick to deny Prophet Abraham his Office, his position, and his place with God Almighty is the deep corruption in which the work of today's Prophets has been mired!

Jeremiah 23:15 (KJV) Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets; Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, and make them drink the water of gall: for from the prophets of Jerusalem is profaneness gone forth into all the land.

Hosea 9:7 (**KJV**) The days of visitation are come, the days of recompence are come; Israel shall know *it*: the prophet *is* a fool, the spiritual man *is* mad, for the multitude of thine iniquity, and the great hatred.

Micah 2:11 (KJV) If a man walking in the spirit and falsehood do lie, *saying*, I will prophesy unto thee of wine and of strong drink; he shall even be the prophet of this people.

Zechariah 13:2 (**KJV**) And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, *that* I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.

Today, what is spoken by the evil spirits of divination is called "prophecy" and so, majority of the people and the congregations have been lied to repeatedly to think falsely that when a man engages in palm reading, daily and monthly prognostication, dream telling and dream doctrines, money rituals and sacrifices to idols, and so on and so forth, then that man is the Prophet when, in **Genesis 20:7 (KJV)**, God Almighty is telling us clearly who the true Prophet of God is!

Daniel 11:38 (KJV) But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things.

Acts 16:16 (KJV) And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:

Acts 16:17 (KJV) The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.

Acts 16:18 (KJV) And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

1 Peter 1:18 (KJV) Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers;

Now, what made Abraham a true Prophet of God Almighty? What are the instruments of the Office of the Prophet that Abraham exercised that made him a true Prophet of God Almighty?

- 1. Abraham obeyed the Word of God! Obedience to God Almighty is the first instrument of the Office of the Prophet
 - i. Genesis 12:1 (KJV) Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
 - ii. **Genesis 12:2 (KJV)** And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:
 - iii. Genesis 12:3 (KJV) And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.
 - iv. **Genesis 12:4 (KJV)** So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram *was* seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.
- 2. Abraham did not call on the name of the LORD everyday but Abraham lived every day in righteousness!
 - i. **Genesis 13:4 (KJV)** Unto the place of the altar, which he had made there at the first: and there Abram called on the name of the LORD.
 - ii. **Genesis 13:14 (KJV)** And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:
- 3. Abraham did not pay tithes out of his own wealth, riches, money, or properties at all in his entire lifetime, but Abraham paid tithes only once in his entire lifetime out of the booty of others that he had captured in war!
 - i. **Genesis 13:2 (KJV)** And Abram *was* very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.

- ii. **Genesis 14:13 (KJV)** And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew; for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: and these *were* confederate with Abram.
- iii. **Genesis 14:14 (KJV)** And when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his trained *servants*, born in his own house, three hundred and eighteen, and pursued *them* unto Dan.
- iv. **Genesis 14:15** (**KJV**) And he divided himself against them, he and his servants, by night, and smote them, and pursued them unto Hobah, which *is* on the left hand of Damascus.
- v. **Genesis 14:16 (KJV)** And he brought back all the goods, and also brought again his brother Lot, and his goods, and the women also, and the people.
- vi. **Genesis 14:17 (KJV)** And the king of Sodom went out to meet him after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, and of the kings that *were* with him, at the valley of Shaveh, which *is* the king's dale.
- vii. **Genesis 14:18 (KJV)** And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he *was* the priest of the most high God.
- viii. **Genesis 14:19 (KJV)** And he blessed him, and said, Blessed *be* Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:
 - ix. Genesis 14:20 (KJV) And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.
- 4. God Almighty was still blessing Abraham even when Abraham was not paying any tithes at all every month as the tithe robbery is done in almost all the churches of today!

- Genesis 15:1 (KJV) After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.
- 5. Another instrument of the Office of the Prophet that Abraham exercised that made him a true Prophet of God Almighty is "believing God Almighty"!
 - i. **Genesis 15:2** (**KJV**) And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house *is* this Eliezer of Damascus?
 - ii. **Genesis 15:3** (**KJV**) And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir.
 - iii. **Genesis 15:4 (KJV)** And, behold, the word of the LORD *came* unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.
 - iv. **Genesis 15:5** (**KJV**) And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.
 - v. **Genesis 15:6** (**KJV**) And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
- 6. Abraham was a true Prophet of God Almighty simply by obeying the Word of God!
 - Genesis 17:5 (KJV) Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.
 - ii. **1 Chronicles 1:27 (KJV)** Abram; the same *is* Abraham.
 - iii. **Nehemiah 9:7 (KJV)** Thou *art* the LORD the God, who didst choose Abram, and broughtest him forth

- out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gavest him the name of Abraham;
- 7. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who prays for the Salvation of other people as God Almighty revealed in **Genesis 20:7 (KJV)**, saying: "and he shall pray for thee"!
 - i. Genesis 20:7 (KJV) Now therefore restore the man his wife; for he is a prophet, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore her not, know thou that thou shalt surely die, thou, and all that are thine.
 - ii. Genesis 17:18 (KJV) And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee!
 - iii. Genesis 17:19 (KJV) And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, *and* with his seed after him.
 - iv. Genesis 17:20 (KJV) And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.
 - v. **Genesis 17:21 (KJV)** But my covenant will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.
 - vi. **Genesis 17:22 (KJV)** And he left off talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.
 - vii. Genesis 17:23 (KJV) And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.

- viii. **Genesis 17:24 (KJV)** And Abraham *was* ninety years old and nine, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin.
 - ix. **Genesis 17:25 (KJV)** And Ishmael his son *was* thirteen years old, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin.
 - x. **Genesis 17:26 (KJV)** In the selfsame day was Abraham circumcised, and Ishmael his son.
 - xi. Genesis 17:27 (KJV) And all the men of his house, born in the house, and bought with money of the stranger, were circumcised with him.
- 8. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who works with his own hands in order to earn wages to feed his family and servants! The Man of God who relies on the work and toil of his congregation to eat and to feed his family is an infidel, has deviated from the faith of Jesus Christ, and is unfit for the Kingdom of God, both he and all his family who eat from the toil of the poor!
 - Genesis 17:23 (KJV) And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.
 - ii. **Acts 18:1 (KJV)** After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth;
 - iii. Acts 18:2 (KJV) And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them.
 - iv. **Acts 18:3 (KJV)** And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers.

- v. **2 Thessalonians 3:10 (KJV)** For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.
- vi. **2 Thessalonians 3:11 (KJV)** For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies.
- vii. **2 Thessalonians 3:12 (KJV)** Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread.
- 9. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who is kind to strangers and helps people!
 - Genesis 18:1 (KJV) And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;
 - ii. **Genesis 18:2 (KJV)** And he lift up his eyes and looked, and, lo, three men stood by him: and when he saw *them*, he ran to meet them from the tent door, and bowed himself toward the ground,
 - iii. **Genesis 18:3 (KJV)** And said, My Lord, if now I have found favour in thy sight, pass not away, I pray thee, from thy servant:
 - iv. **Genesis 18:4 (KJV)** Let a little water, I pray you, be fetched, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree:
 - v. **Genesis 18:5** (**KJV**) And I will fetch a morsel of bread, and comfort ye your hearts; after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said.
 - vi. **Genesis 18:6 (KJV)** And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal, knead *it*, and make cakes upon the hearth.

- vii. **Genesis 18:7 (KJV)** And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetcht a calf tender and good, and gave *it* unto a young man; and he hasted to dress it.
- 10. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who does not join himself to his wife to lie to God Almighty or to do evil in the sight of God Almighty as Adam joined himself to his wife Eve to sin against God Almighty!
 - i. Genesis 3:6 (KJV) And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.
 - ii. **Genesis 3:12 (KJV)** And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.
 - iii. **Genesis 18:9 (KJV)** And they said unto him, Where *is* Sarah thy wife? And he said, Behold, in the tent.
 - iv. **Genesis 18:10 (KJV)** And he said, I will certainly return unto thee according to the time of life; and, lo, Sarah thy wife shall have a son. And Sarah heard *it* in the tent door, which *was* behind him.
 - v. **Genesis 18:11 (KJV)** Now Abraham and Sarah *were* old *and* well stricken in age; *and* it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women.
 - vi. **Genesis 18:12 (KJV)** Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?
 - vii. **Genesis 18:13 (KJV)** And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?
 - viii. **Genesis 18:14 (KJV)** Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee,

- according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.
- ix. **Genesis 18:15 (KJV)** Then Sarah denied, saying, I laughed not; for she was afraid. And he said, Nay; but thou didst laugh.
- x. **Genesis 18:16 (KJV)** And the men rose up from thence, and looked toward Sodom: and Abraham went with them to bring them on the way.
- xi. **Job 31:33 (KJV)** If I covered my transgressions as Adam, by hiding mine iniquity in my bosom:
- xii. **1 Timothy 2:14 (KJV)** And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.
- 11. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who teaches the knowledge of God and commandments of God Almighty to his family and people!
 - i. **Genesis 18:17 (KJV)** And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do;
 - ii. **Genesis 18:18 (KJV)** Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?
 - iii. Genesis 18:19 (KJV) For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.
- 12. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who runs the church that is in his house and whose teachings and doctrines focus only on three topics:
 - i. keep the way of the LORD
 - ii. to do justice and
 - iii. judgment, meaning Word of God

- 13. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who becomes aware of a coming evil, calamity or death to a person or a people, not through dreams, or voices in the air, or from Angels, or from familiar spirits, witches or wizards, but through Christian Counseling, and then after he has known the coming evil, calamity or death, he goes before God Almighty to intercede for the person or people who are going to die without saying a word to the person or people anything about spiritual direction!
 - Genesis 18:22 (KJV) And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD.
 - ii. Genesis 18:23 (KJV) And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?
 - iii. **Genesis 18:24 (KJV)** Peradventure there be fifty righteous within the city: wilt thou also destroy and not spare the place for the fifty righteous that *are* therein?
 - iv. Genesis 18:25 (KJV) That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?
 - v. **Genesis 18:26 (KJV)** And the LORD said, If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes.
 - vi. **Genesis 18:27 (KJV)** And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which *am but* dust and ashes:
 - vii. **Genesis 18:28 (KJV)** Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt thou destroy all the city for *lack of* five? And he said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy *it*.

- viii. **Genesis 18:29 (KJV)** And he spake unto him yet again, and said, Peradventure there shall be forty found there. And he said, I will not do *it* for forty's sake.
- ix. **Genesis 18:30 (KJV)** And he said *unto him*, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak: Peradventure there shall thirty be found there. And he said, I will not do *it*, if I find thirty there.
- x. **Genesis 18:31 (KJV)** And he said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord: Peradventure there shall be twenty found there. And he said, I will not destroy *it* for twenty's sake.
- xi. **Genesis 18:32 (KJV)** And he said, Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And he said, I will not destroy *it* for ten's sake.
- xii. **Genesis 18:33 (KJV)** And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.
- 14. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who prays for people for God Almighty to help them without telling them that he is praying for them! In other words, a true Prophet of God Almighty prays in secret to God Almighty for people and does not advertise it openly that he has been praying for them neither does he even tell them what type of prayer he has been praying for them!
 - Genesis 20:6 (KJV) And God said unto him in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from sinning against me: therefore suffered I thee not to touch her.
 - ii. **Genesis 20:7 (KJV)** Now therefore restore the man *his* wife; for he *is* a prophet, and he shall pray for thee, and thou shalt live: and if thou restore *her* not,

- know thou that thou shalt surely die, thou, and all that *are* thine.
- iii. **Genesis 20:17 (KJV)** So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare *children*.
- iv. Genesis 20:18 (KJV) For the LORD had fast closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech, because of Sarah Abraham's wife.
- 15. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who obeys God Almighty even if that obedience is to the hurt of his own family! In other words, a true Prophet of God Almighty chooses the Word of God Almighty over everyone else in his family!
 - Genesis 21:9 (KJV) And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking.
 - ii. **Genesis 21:10 (KJV)** Wherefore she said unto Abraham, Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, *even* with Isaac.
 - iii. **Genesis 21:11 (KJV)** And the thing was very grievous in Abraham's sight because of his son.
 - iv. Genesis 21:12 (KJV) And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.
 - v. **Genesis 21:13 (KJV)** And also of the son of the bondwoman will I make a nation, because he *is* thy seed.
 - vi. **Genesis 21:14 (KJV)** And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave *it* unto Hagar, putting *it* on her shoulder,

- and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beer-sheba.
- vii. **Luke 14:25** (**KJV**) And there went great multitudes with him: and he turned, and said unto them,
- viii. **Luke 14:26 (KJV)** If any *man* come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.
- ix. Luke 14:27 (KJV) And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.
- 16. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who does not openly tell people that he is a Prophet, who does not deal falsely with anyone, but people see the hand of God in him and they bear testimony to him!
 - i. **Genesis 21:22 (KJV)** And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phichol the chief captain of his host spake unto Abraham, saying, God *is* with thee in all that thou doest:
 - ii. **Genesis 21:23 (KJV)** Now therefore swear unto me here by God that thou wilt not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my son's son: *but* according to the kindness that I have done unto thee, thou shalt do unto me, and to the land wherein thou hast sojourned.
 - iii. **Genesis 21:24 (KJV)** And Abraham said, I will swear.
 - iv. **John 4:19 (KJV)** The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.
- 17. Abraham did not call on God Almighty every day but one thing that he did every day was obey God Almighty and live in truth and righteousness!

- Genesis 21:33 (KJV) And Abraham planted a grove in Beer-sheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.
- 18. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who while serving God Almighty, still goes through adversity and affliction, but is steadfast in believing and trusting God Almighty even in the affliction and adversity!
 - i. **Genesis 22:1 (KJV)** And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, *here* I *am*.
 - ii. **Genesis 22:2 (KJV)** And he said, Take now thy son, thine only *son* Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.
 - iii. Genesis 22:3 (KJV) And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.
 - iv. **Genesis 22:4 (KJV)** Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.
 - v. Genesis 22:5 (KJV) And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you.
 - vi. **Genesis 22:6 (KJV)** And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid *it* upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together.
 - vii. **Genesis 22:7** (**KJV**) And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here *am*

- I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where *is* the lamb for a burnt offering?
- viii. **Genesis 22:8 (KJV)** And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.
 - ix. Genesis 22:9 (KJV) And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.
 - x. **Genesis 22:10 (KJV)** And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.
 - xi. **Genesis 22:11 (KJV)** And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here *am* I.
- xii. **Genesis 22:12 (KJV)** And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only *son* from me.
- xiii. **Genesis 22:13 (KJV)** And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind *him* a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.
- xiv. **Genesis 22:14 (KJV)** And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah-jireh: as it is said *to* this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.
- xv. **Genesis 22:15 (KJV)** And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time,
- xvi. **Genesis 22:16 (KJV)** And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done

- this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only *son*:
- xvii. **Genesis 22:17 (KJV)** That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which *is* upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;
- xviii. **Genesis 22:18 (KJV)** And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.
 - xix. Genesis 22:19 (KJV) So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beer-sheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beer-sheba.
- 19. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who does not divine the future for people. Abraham did not help people to find wives and husbands. Abraham did not tell people that if they give him money, then God Almighty would solve their problems for them. Abraham did not tell any congregation to stretch forth their palm so he can read their palms and speak their future to them. Abraham did not ask people to tell him what dreams they had for him to interpret their dreams to them. Abraham did not do any signs, miracles, and wonders. Abraham did not foresee the future of anyone neither did he foresee his own future. Abraham never engaged in forecasting and predicting future political elections.
- 20. A true Prophet of God Almighty like Abraham is the one who simply repeats in righteousness the original prophecy that God Almighty gave!
 - i. Isaiah 2:4 (KJV) And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

- ii. **Micah 4:3 (KJV)** And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.
- iii. **Zechariah 3:2 (KJV)** And the LORD said unto Satan, The LORD rebuke thee, O Satan; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: *is* not this a brand plucked out of the fire?
- iv. **Jude 9** (**KJV**) Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- v. **Micah 7:6** (**KJV**) For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies *are* the men of his own house.
- vi. Matthew 10:36 (KJV) And a man's foes *shall be* they of his own household.

If you are a true Christian, if you are a true church of Christ, what you can do with these 20 definitions of a true Prophet of God is to ask yourself whether you live by them, whether these are the true definitions that guide you in your prophetic Ministry. These 20 definitions are the original true and correct definitions of the First Template of the Prophet, the First Office of the Prophet in the Bible.

By the time Jesus Christ came in the New Testament, the marriage institution had become deeply corrupted and deviated from God Almighty just as the Office of the Prophet had become deeply corrupted and deviated from God Almighty:

Mark 10:1 (KJV) And he arose from thence, and cometh into the coasts of Judaea by the farther side of Jordan: and the people resort unto him again; and, as he was wont, he taught them again.

Mark 10:2 (KJV) And the Pharisees came to him, and asked him, Is it lawful for a man to put away *his* wife? tempting him.

Mark 10:3 (KJV) And he answered and said unto them, What did Moses command you?

Mark 10:4 (KJV) And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement, and to put *her* away.

Mark 10:5 (KJV) And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the hardness of your heart he wrote you this precept.

Mark 10:6 (KJV) But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female.

Mark 10:7 (KJV) For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife;

Mark 10:8 (KJV) And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh.

Mark 10:9 (KJV) What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

Mark 10:10 (KJV) And in the house his disciples asked him again of the same *matter*.

Mark 10:11 (KJV) And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committeth adultery against her.

Mark 10:12 (KJV) And if a woman shall put away her husband, and be married to another, she committeth adultery.

As a result, Jesus Christ re-instated the true, correct, and proper *marriage institution without divorce* as we see in Mark 10:1-12 (KJV). Similarly, Jesus Christ re-instated the true, correct, and proper *Office of the Prophet without signs, miracles, and wonders*, and John the Baptist was the First of such Prophets in the New Testament!

Luke 1:76 (KJV) And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways;

Luke 1:77 (**KJV**) To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins,

Luke 1:78 (KJV) Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,

Luke 1:79 (KJV) To give light to them that sit in darkness and *in* the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

Luke 1:80 (KJV) And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, and was in the deserts till the day of his shewing unto Israel.

Luke 7:24 (KJV) And when the messengers of John were departed, he began to speak unto the people concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness for to see? A reed shaken with the wind?

Luke 7:25 (KJV) But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? Behold, they which are gorgeously apparelled, and live delicately, are in kings' courts.

Luke 7:26 (KJV) But what went ye out for to see? A prophet? Yea, I say unto you, and much more than a prophet.

Luke 7:27 (KJV) This is *he*, of whom it is written, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.

Luke 7:28 (KJV) For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.

Luke 7:29 (KJV) And all the people that heard *him*, and the publicans, justified God, being baptized with the baptism of John.

John 10:41 (KJV) And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.

In other words, in the beginning, as Jesus Christ said, there was no divorce in marriage, and there was no signs, miracles, and wonders in the Office of the Prophet! From the Scriptures, therefore, especially from the life of Abraham as the First Prophet of God Almighty in the Holy Bible, Jesus Christ simply returned those two institutions to their original true, correct and proper definitions and functions!

Luke 16:16 (KJV) The law and the prophets *were* until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.

The question is: Will people hear the Truth? Will people accept the Truth? Will people receive the Truth? Will people acknowledge the Truth? Will people practise the Truth to give God Glory?

Isaiah 53:1 (KJV) Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?

Luke 18:8 (KJV) I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?

John 12:38 (KJV) That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who hath believed our report? and to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed?

Romans 10:16 (KJV) But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?

Just as it was in the Days of the Flesh of Jesus Christ when the lie was more acceptable to the church leaders and to the people, where the lie and the false doctrine had majority of the people flocking after the lie, so it is also today where only a minority want to accept, receive, acknowledge, and practise the Truth that the New Testament Prophet does not do signs, miracles and wonders!

Revelation 2:7 (KJV) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

Revelation 2:11 (KJV) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

Revelation 2:29 (KJV) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

If we say that we are in the New Testament, and yet Abraham in the Old Testament is our father, can a father bequeath and bestow what he never possessed to his children? Is that possible at all in any wise? No! Therefore, if your father Abraham did not do miracles, signs, and wonders and you the son you are doing them, then surely, Abraham is not your father but your real father is in **John 8:44** (**KJV**)!

Matthew 3:9 (KJV) And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

Luke 1:73 (KJV) The oath which he sware to our father Abraham,

Luke 3:8 (KJV) Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

John 8:44 (KJV) Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

John 8:53 (KJV) Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself?

Acts 7:2 (KJV) And he said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,

Romans 4:1 (KJV) What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?

Romans 4:12 (KJV) And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which *he had* being *yet* uncircumcised.

James 2:21 (KJV) Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?

Men of God, search the Scriptures and consider whether all the things, doctrines, performances, and utterances that you are offering in your prophetic séances and churches, whether Abraham did same or not! If not, then Abraham is not your father because it is impossible for a father to give what he prior did not possess to his children!

John 8:39 (KJV) They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham.

John 8:44 (KJV) Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

And if Abraham is not your father because your own works and words from your own mouth reveal who you truly are and whose son and servant you are, then you are not saved, then you are not born again, then you have no part with Jesus Christ, then God Almighty did not call you neither does Yahweh Almighty know you!

Isaiah 8:20 (KJV) To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, *it is* because *there is* no light in them.

Matthew 12:33 (KJV) Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by *his* fruit.

Matthew 12:34 (KJV) O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

Matthew 12:35 (KJV) A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

Matthew 12:36 (KJV) But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

Matthew 12:37 (KJV) For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Luke 6:45 (KJV) A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

John 3:34 (**KJV**) For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure *unto him*.

John 8:39 (KJV) They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham.

The LORD Jesus Christ be with your spirit. The LORD Jesus Christ give you understanding.
